

Musical Group/Artist Web Page

Date Due: November 18, 2009

Research your favorite musical group or artist and create your own web site about that group/artist. The web pages should be eye appealing and contain information about the group/artist:

Suggested Content:

- ◆ Brief history of when the artist/group started, who they played with or for in the beginning.
- ◆ Any accomplishments—like awards etc...
- ◆ List past and present CD's
- ◆ Some personal information about the person/group—where they live or record, married, etc...
- ◆ A picture gallery of the group/artist

Criteria to include on page:

- ◆ Title of group/artist should stand out on the home page
- ◆ You must include at least 3 html web pages, not including the Home Page
- ◆ Apply a theme of your choice to all the web pages or create your own theme and follow it through on all pages
- ◆ The name of the artist/group must appear in the title bar on the Home Page
- ◆ The other pages must have a title that pertains to the pages.
- ◆ Use a footer with webmasters name and date last updated
- ◆ The photo gallery should include captions and may include descriptions
- ◆ Include a table with at least 2 columns and 1 row. Apply at least 3 table features such as borders, alignment, cell padding, cell spacing, colored background, split cells, etc...
- ◆ Include a forms page on the site. This could be a questionnaire about the visitors favorite song/CD, a form to join the fan club, or any relevant type of information. Include several types of form attributes.
- ◆ Include 3 links from one of your web pages to other sites about the same artist/group. May use text, buttons, or pictures to link but the links must be easy to identify.
- ◆ All Pictures were set to web quality (not to big and doesn't take to long to load)
- ◆ Use other features to make the appearance of your pages attractive. Be sure that pictures are small enough that there are not large gaps between text. Font sizes should be normal for reading on the screen with titles in larger or bold print. There should not be large empty areas on the page nor should the text and pictures be crammed together. **PROOFREAD!!!**
- ◆ Project is completed on time.
- ◆ Website is stored on the network in the specified location: Mrs. Schaffer's Classroom/5th Hour Multimedia/Web Design/ Music Projects.

These web sites will be shared with the class and a peer evaluation will be done on them. I will score the projects using the scoring guide. **View each of the web pages in a browser .**
