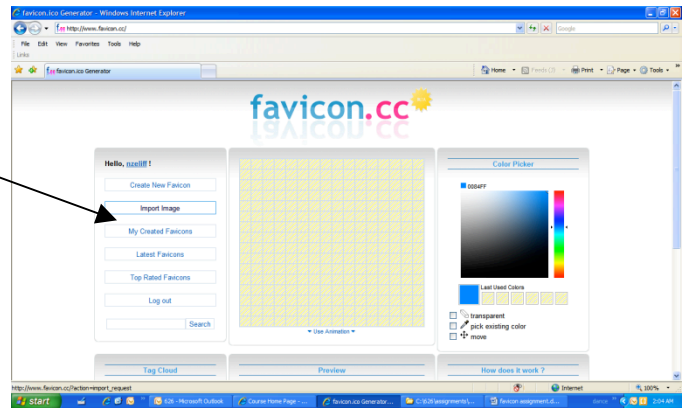
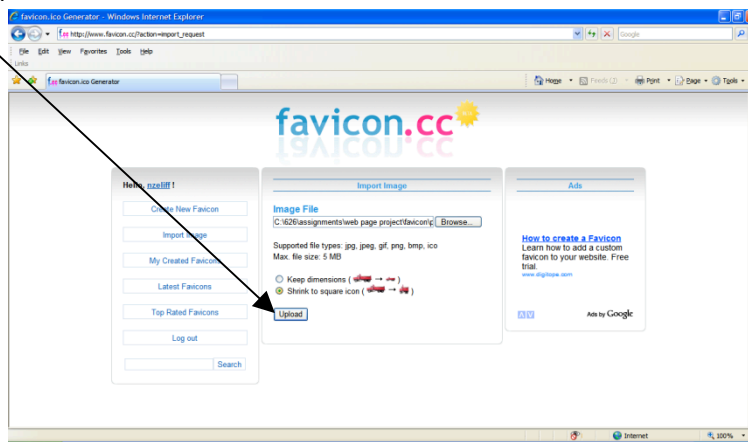

**Favicon Assignment - To use in Web Page Project – on each page**

1. Decide upon a graphic to use that depicts your web page.
2. Save that graphic in the folder where your web page project files are.
3. Go to <http://www.favicon.cc>
4. Click on “Import Image”

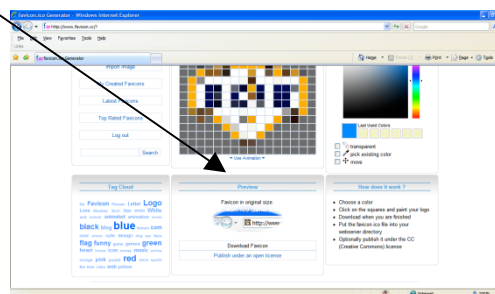


5. Browse your computer for the graphic file and “shrink to square icon” and press “Upload”



6. Your image will show up in a pixel grid and will appear to be distorted.
7. Click on “Download image” and save the generated .ico icon file in your web page project folder.
8. *Rename* the file with a short descriptive file name and the extension of .gif (*don't convert it to a .gif, just rename it—simply by removing .ico and putting .gif*)

Let's say in this example, you renamed your icon *favicon.gif*



9. Open in Dreamweaver each of your web pages. In the HTML code, enter the HTML code below in the line after the <HEAD> in each web page file and save the .html files.  
`<link rel="shortcut icon" href="favicon.gif"/>`
10. Now copy the *favicon.gif* file and the *edited .html files* to your web server and the appropriate folder for this web page project. Your favicon will appear in the address line on each page.
